APOLOGIES

106/24 Cllrs Geoff Mason and Julia Kiggell sent their apologies.

DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

107/24 There were none.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

108/24 It was resolved the minutes of the Amenities Committee meeting held on 27th February 2024, and previously distributed to members via Board Intelligence, be accepted as a correct record.

QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC AND PRESS

109/24 There were none.

MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION

110/24 To Elect a Chairman of the Amenities Committee

Cllr Alison Webster proposed Cllr David Knight, Cllr Caroline Richards seconded and this was unanimously agreed by those present. **Resolved:** Cllr David Knight is the Chairman of the Amenities Committee.

111/24 *To Resolve to Co-opt Cllr Suzie Kember as an additional member of the Amenities Committee*

Cllr David Knight explained that Cllr Suzie Kember had expressed an interest in joining the Amenities Committee. **Resolved:** Cllr Suzie Kember be added as an additional member of the Amenities Committee. **Action: Assistant Clerk to update website, noticeboards.**

112/24 **To receive an update and make a decision on painting the new Goudhurst phone box** The Assistant Clerk gave an update regarding the feedback from the painters that had been asked to quote. There was a discussion regarding the possibility of replacing the new phone box with an old-style telephone box and whether the defibrillator could be installed in the old-style phone box. The Assistant Clerk informed the Committee that there had been discussion of social media regarding using the new box as a book exchange. Cllr Webster stated that there was already a book exchange in the Social Club. Cllr Harris to add this information in the June Newsletter. **Action:** Assistant Clerk to establish whether the defibrillator could be installed in the old phone box.

113/24 To Resolve to appoint a contractor to install the AED in the old phonebox The Assistant Clerk informed the Committee that B&K had quoted for the work. Resolved: B&K be appointed to install the AED to be paid from budget code 5108. Action: Assistant Clerk to liaise with Cllr Kirkby.

114/24 *To receive an update on the Millennium Walk sign posting, including the number of posts required and decide on any action needed*

Cllr Richards walked the route last week and identified where the new information discs could be installed and whether any new posts were required. **Resolved**: It was agreed that expenditure of up to £200 was acceptable. **Action:** Cllr Richards to order 45 information discs from Iden Signs. **Resolved:** to be paid from budget code 5382.

115/24 **To resolve the expenditure of £850 for painting the village sign on The Plain** Cllr Knight explained that the Parish Council need to take the sign down and taken to A&C Blasting Services. It was also noted that the supporting post needs to be replaced. There was discussion whether the new post should be oak or composite and also the location of the sign. **Resolved:** Assistant Clerk to arrange for the sign to be taken down and taken to A&C Blasting Services and to obtain quotes for the replacement post. **Resolved:** It was resolved to approve the expenditure of £850 for the painting of the village sign on The Plain and be paid from budget code 5325. **Action:** Assistant Clerk to obtain quotes for replacement post and action sign removal and repair.

116/24 *To resolve to replace the damaged bench on The Plain.*

There was a discussion to identify which bench was damaged and what the damage was. **Resolved:** to replace the damaged bench on The Plain and be paid from budget code 5325. **Action:** Assistant Clerk to order replacement bench.

117/24 *To resolve the expenditure of £950 for Kilndown The Quarry and £750 for the Village Pond for water treatment*

Cllr Webster explained that she had a site visit with Marion Sargeant who provided a lot of very useful knowledge regarding the drainage, filters for the village pond. Assistant Clerk updated the Committee that the water treatment for the Quarry Pond could not be carried out until the pond has been cleared. **Resolved:** Cllr Read-Cutting to liaise with Marion Sargeant (Goudhurst Village pond) and Tony Bovey (Quarry Pond) and for the payment to be made from budget code 5300. **Action:** Cllr Harris to provide contact details for Cllr Read-Cutting. Cllr Read-Cutting to contact Marion and Tony. Assistant Clerk to arrange water treatment for the village pond.

118/24 *To receive an update regarding The Plain Information Board and decide on any further action needed.*

Cllr Wester informed the Committee that the sign was in the process of being made and everything was moving forward. **Resolved:** to be paid from reserves.

119/24 *To receive an update and decide on any action needed regarding the Duck House.* Assistant Clerk gave an update on the work being carried out on the Duck House. Action: Assistant Clerk to chase up contractor with a view to having it repaired and returned to the pond ASAP. **Resolved:** to be paid from budget code 5300.

120/24 *To receive feedback on the litter bin collection from TWBC and decide on any action needed.*

Action: Assistant Clerk to check progress with TWBC.

121/24 To resolve the addition of two Goudhurst Village Hall cameras on the Goudhurst Parish Council system.

There was a discussion regarding the current CCTV provision and its effectiveness. It was **resolved** for Cllr Webster to contact the current providers and discuss the issues. **Action:** Assistant Clerk to email Hall BT letter to Cllr Knight. Cllr Kirkby and Cllr Hodgskin to contact Village Hall Committee and identify need.

122/24 *To resolve to re-instigate the investigation of one, unified CCTV system.* Cllr Webster asked whether this should take place when the Parish Council move to the new office. **Action:** Cllr Webster to liaise with current provider.

- 123/24 *To resolve to keep the spare St Mary's Days Garage for Parish Council storage.* **Resolved:** to keep the spare St Mary's Days Garage for Parish Council storage.
- 124/24 To discuss and make a decision on next steps for the outside gym.

The Committee are positive about this issue but are concerned about the costs. Action: Assistant Clerk to investigate costings, discuss funding with the RFO. Assistant Clerk to add the Petanque Pitch to the next Amenities Committee Agenda. **Resolved:** any costs would come out of reserves.

125/24 *To resolve to tidy the trough on The Plain and decide on any action needed.*

It was noted that Cllr Webster and Marion Sargeant had visited the trough and tidied and cleaned it the previous week and the Assistant Clerk had purchased and planted up bedding plants in the trough that weekend. The Committee passed on their thanks for this work. There was discussion regarding the trimming of overhead branches.

Action: Assistant Clerk to arrange for contractor to trim overhead branches. **Resolved:** expenses to be paid from budget code 5300.

MADE IN BRITAIN

UK Sourced Materials – 99% of our component part materials is sourced within the UK meaning we have tighter control over our production and supply. Raw materials and parts are bulk ordered with high re-order levels to ensure we are never without stock of materials & parts.



Parts Fabrication – we are continually making batches of component parts for our products. Once an order is received it is added to the Production Schedule for parts to be picked and sent to the Paint Shop.



Painting Process – all parts are primed and powder coated in house through our paint plant.





1. DEFINITIONS

Business Day: A day (other than a Saturday Sunday or Public Holiday) when banks in London are open for business. Conditions: The Terms & Conditions set out in this document as amended from time to time.

TGO: The Great Outdoor Gym Company Ltd registered in England and Wales with Company Number: 6041524.

Contract: The Contract between TGO and the Customer for the sale and purchase of the goods or the sale and purchase and installation of the goods in accordance with these Conditions.

Customer: The person, firm, corporate body or public sector authority who purchases the goods from TGO.

Force Majeure Event: An event of circumstance beyond the party's reasonable control.

Goods: The Goods (or any part of them) set out in the order.

Order: The Customer's Order for the Goods as set out in the Customer's purchase order form or the Customer's written acceptance of TGO's quotation.

Specifications: Any Specification for the Goods including any related plans and drawings provided by TGO.

2. INTERPRETATION

- (a) A reference to a statute or statutory provision is a reference to such statute or provision as amended or re-enacted. A reference to a statute or statutory provision includes any subordinate legislation made under that statute or statutory provision as amended or reenacted.
- (b) Any phrase introduced by the terms including, include, in particular or any similar expression shall be construed as illustrative and shall not limit the sense of the words preceding those terms.

(c) A reference to writing, written or includes emails.

3. BASIS OF CONTRACT

- 3.1 These conditions apply to the Contract to the exclusion of any other terms that the Customer seeks to impose or incorporate, or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing.
- 3.2 The Order constitutes an offer by the Customer to purchase the Goods in accordance with these Conditions. The Customer is responsible for ensuring that the terms of the Order are complete and accurate.

- 3.4 The Customer waives any right it might otherwise have to rely upon any terms endorsed upon, delivered with or contained in any documents of the Customer that is inconsistent with these Conditions.
- 3.5 Any samples, drawings, descriptive matter or advertising produced by TGO and any descriptions or illustrations contained in TGO's catalogues or brochures are produced for the sole purpose of giving an approximate idea of the goods referred to in them. They shall not form part of the Contract nor have any contractual force.
- 3.6 A quotation for the Goods given by TGO shall not constitute an offer. A quotation shall only be valid for a period of 20 business days from its date of issue.

4. GOODS

5.

- 4.1 The Goods are described in TGO's catalogue as modified by any item or change specified in the quotation produced by TGO.
- 4.2 TGO reserves the right to amend the Specification of the Goods if required by any applicable statutory or regulatory requirements. **DELIVERY**
- 5.1 TGO supplies its Goods on an ex works basis. The Customer shall collect the Goods from TGO's manufacturer's premises or such other location as may be advised by TGO prior to collection within 3 business days of TGO notifying the Customer that the Goods are ready.
- 5.2 Delivery is completed on the completion of loading of the Goods at the collection location.
- 5.3 Any dates quoted for delivery are approximate only and the time of delivery is not of the essence. TGO shall not be liable for any delay in delivery of the Goods that is caused by a Force Majeure Event or the Customer's failure to provide TGO with any instructions that are relevant to the supply of the Goods.
- 5.4 If TGO fails to deliver the Goods its liability shall be limited to the costs and expenses incurred by the customer in obtaining replacement Goods of similar description and quality in the cheapest market available, less the price of the Goods.  (a) Delivery of the Goods shall be deemed to have been completed at 9.00am on the third business day after the day on which TGO notified the Customer that the Goods were ready; and
- (b) TGO shall store the Goods until collection takes place and charge the Customer for all related costs and expenses
- 5.6 If 15 business days after the day on which TGO notified the Customer that the Goods were ready for collection and the Customer has not made collection of the Goods TGO may resell or otherwise dispose of part or all of the Goods and after deducting reasonable storage and selling costs account to the Customer for any excess over the price of the Goods or charge the Customer for any shortfall below the price of the Goods.
- 5.7 TGO may deliver the goods by up to 3 instalments which shall be invoiced and paid for separately. Any delay in delivery or defect in an instalment shall not entitle the customer to cancel any other instalment.
- 5.8 In the event of any of the Goods collected by the Customer being damaged the Customer must report that damage to TGO on the same day as collection.

Rubber handles, USB ports, batteries and polyurethane traveler wheels are not covered by warranty but should be replaced during maintenance if required.







We will keep a record of the detailed specification of your equipment to ensure the spares for your equipment are available for the duration of the contract.





TERMS & CONDITIONS of TRADING THE GREAT OUTDOOR GYM COMPANY LTD

1. DEFINITIONS

Business Day: A day (other than a Saturday Sunday or Public Holiday) when banks in London are open for business. Conditions: The Terms & Conditions set out in this document as amended from time to time. TGO: The Great Outdoor Gym Company Ltd registered in England and Wales with Company Number: 6041524. Contract: The Contract between TGO and the Customer for the sale and purchase of the goods or the sale and purchase and installation of the goods in accordance with these Conditions. Customer: The person, firm, corporate body or public sector authority who purchases the goods from TGO. Force Majeure Event: An event of circumstance beyond the party's reasonable control.

Goods: The Goods (or any part of them) set out in the order.

Order: The Customer's Order for the Goods as set out in the Customer's purchase order form or the Customer's written acceptance of TGO's quotation. Specifications: Any Specification for the Goods including any related plans and drawings provided by TGO.

2. INTERPRETATION

(a) A reference to a statute or statutory provision is a reference to such statute or provision as amended or re-enacted. A reference to a statute or statutory provision includes any subordinate legislation made under that statute or statutory provision as amended or re-enacted.

(b) Any phrase introduced by the terms including, include, in particular or any similar expression shall be construed as illustrative and shall not limit the sense of the words preceding those terms.

(c) A reference to writing, written or includes emails.

3. BASIS OF CONTRACT

3.1 These conditions apply to the Contract to the exclusion of any other terms that the Customer seeks to impose or incorporate, or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing.

3.2 The Order constitutes an offer by the Customer to purchase the Goods in accordance with these Conditions. The Customer is responsible for ensuring that the terms of the Order are complete and accurate.

3.3 The Order shall only be deemed to be accepted when TGO issues an acknowledgement of order at which point the Contract shall come into existence. 3.4 The Customer waives any right it might otherwise have to rely upon any terms endorsed upon, delivered with or contained in any documents of the Customer that is inconsistent with these Conditions.

3.5 Any samples, drawings, descriptive matter or advertising produced by TGO and any descriptions or illustrations contained in TGO's catalogues or brochures are produced for the sole purpose of giving an approximate idea of the goods referred to in them. They shall not form part of the Contract nor have any contractual force.

3.6 A quotation for the Goods given by TGO shall not constitute an offer. A quotation shall only be valid for a period of 20 business days from its date of issue.

4. GOODS

4.1 The Goods are described in TGO's catalogue as modified by any item or change specified in the quotation produced by TGO.

4.2 TGO reserves the right to amend the Specification of the Goods if required by any applicable statutory or regulatory requirements.

5. DELIVERY

5.1 TGO supplies its Goods on an ex works basis. The Customer shall collect the Goods from TGO's manufacturer's premises or such other location as may be advised by TGO prior to collection within 3 business days of TGO notifying the Customer that the Goods are ready.

5.2 Delivery is completed on the completion of loading of the Goods at the collection location.

5.3 Any dates quoted for delivery are approximate only and the time of delivery is not of the essence. TGO shall not be liable for any delay in delivery of the Goods that is caused by a Force Majeure Event or the Customer's failure to provide TGO with any instructions that are relevant to the supply of the Goods. 5.4 If TGO fails to deliver the Goods its liability shall be limited to the costs and expenses incurred by the customer in obtaining replacement Goods of similar description and quality in the cheapest market available, less the price of the Goods. TGO shall have no liability for any failure to deliver the Goods to the extent that such failure is caused by a Force Majeure Event or the Customer's failure to provide TGO with adequate instructions which are relevant to the supply of the Goods.

5.5 If the Customer fails to collect the Goods within 3 business days of TGO notifying the Customer that the Goods are ready, then, except where such failure or delay is caused by a Force Majeure Event or TGO's failure to comply with its obligations under the Contract:

(a) Delivery of the Goods shall be deemed to have been completed at 9.00am on the third business day after the day on which TGO notified the Customer that the Goods were ready; and

(b) TGO shall store the Goods until collection takes place and charge the Customer for all related costs and expenses

5.6 If 15 business days after the day on which TGO notified the Customer that the Goods were ready for collection and the Customer has not made collection of the Goods TGO may resell or otherwise dispose of part or all of the Goods and after deducting reasonable storage and selling costs account to the Customer for any excess over the price of the Goods or charee the Customer for any shortfall below the price of the Goods.

5.7 TGO may deliver the goods by up to 3 instalments which shall be invoiced and paid for separately. Any delay in delivery or defect in an instalment shall not entitle the customer to cancel any other instalment.

5.8 In the event of any of the Goods collected by the Customer being damaged the Customer must report that damage to TGO on the same day as collection. 5.9 In the event of TGO agreeing to deliver the Goods to the Customer and in the event of those Goods being found to be damaged the Customer must report the damage to TGO on the same day as delivery to the Customer.

5.10 If the Customer fails to report damage as required by Clauses 5.8 and 5.9 TGO shall not be liable to the Customer for any loss arising from the damage.

6 QUALITY

6.1 TGO warrants that on delivery and for a period of 12 months from the date of delivery (warranty period) the Goods shall: (a) Conform in all material respects with their description; and

(b) be free from material defects in design material and workmanship; and

6.2 TGO further warrants components of its Goods:

25 YEAR WARRANTY on the structural integrity of steel posts, all welds, bars and steel structural equipment.

10 YEAR WARRANTY against significant corrosion on galvanised products, which are erected at least 250m from the coastline.

5 YEAR WARRANTY on galvanised products, which are situated within 250m of the coastline.

5 YEAR PAINT WARRANTY for paintwork against material fade from exposure to ultra violet light.

1 YEAR WARRANTY on green energy gym electronics excluding batteries and USB ports. 2 YEAR WARRANTY on bearings and bearing cases.

2 YEAR WARRANTY on plastic or composite parts, seats and fittings and clamps.

1 YEAR WARRANTY on gears.

Rubber handles, USB ports, batteries and polyurethane traveller wheels are not covered by warranty but should be replaced during maintenance if required. 6.3 The warranties given in 6.1 and 6.2 above are made upon the following conditions:

(a) The Warranty begins from the date of dispatch from the TGO warehouse.

(b) Customers must satisfy themselves that they can carry out the maintenance instructions proficiently using adequately trained engineers. (c) These warranties do not cover installation faults. Customers must satisfy themselves that installations have been carried out in accordance with the installation instructions specified by TGO.

(d) TGO shall replace faulty products by sending the replacement part to a designated warehouse. TGO shall pay for posting and packaging. The customer may be required to return the faulty part within 30 days at their own cost.

(e) The Customer must pay for the labour cost of the maintenance engineer to carry out all works necessary to diagnose, extract the faulty part, leave the site safe and reinstall safely the replacement part.

(f) The Customer shall assess the risk of the site pending repair or during repair to ensure that there is no risk to the health and safety of the general public. (g) In the event of the Customer or appointed maintenance contractor not carrying out its maintenance obligations as set out in TGO's maintenance instructions published from time to time by TGO on its website or in writing these warranties shall be null and void. TGO shall be entitled to request to see

the Customer's maintenance log books from time to time with the names, dates and signatures of engineers.

(h) Non galvanised product must not be situated within 1km of the coast.

(i) The warranties do not cover damage caused by accident, negligence, normal wear and tear, failure to maintain or misuse.

(j) The Customer must report all warranty claims within 14 days. The report to TGO must include correct name of product, installation date, a photo of the manufacturing label, photographic evidence and clear description of issues.

(k) The Customer may assign the benefit of the guarantee to a purchaser of or a successor of title to the gym equipment provided that the Customer sends within 4 weeks of the assignment a copy of the same to TGO plus a fee of £75 plus vat.

(1) TGO shall not be liable for any consequential loss or damage arising from the failure of the equipment other than for loss or damage which arise from personal injury or death for which no limit on liability is placed.

(m) The warranties do not cover consumable items.

6.4 Except as provided in this clause TGO shall have no liability to the Customer in respect of the Goods failure to comply with the warranty set out in Clause 6.1.

6.5 The terms implied by Sections 13 to 15 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 are, to the fullest extent permitted by law, excluded from the Contract.

6.6 The Conditions shall apply to any repaired or replacements Goods supplied by TGO.

6.7 The TGO Warranties do not apply to branded goods bought in from other manufacturers to fill the customer's order. The liability of TGO in relation to those goods is limited to the warranty provided by those manufacturers.

6.8 No warranty against corrosion is given for any product galvanised or not which is in direct and regular contact with chlorinated water salt water or salt spray.

7 SAFETY

7.1 Customers must ensure that all Goods purchased from TGO are installed by competent workmen using high quality materials and in accordance with Standard EN16630.

7.2 Immediately following the installation of the Goods referred to above the Customer must arrange for the installation to be inspected by a Registered Play Inspector and obtain a certificate that the installation is safe and has been made in accordance with Standard EN16630 and TGO's installation manual. 7.3 In the event of any fault occurring in any of the Goods the Customer shall take out of service to the public the product to which the fault relates until the

faulty product has been repaired/replaced. 7.4 TGO shall be entitled to send to the customer product defect warnings and in the event of the Customer receiving any such warning the Customer shall act on the recommendations of TGO incorporated within the product warning so as to ensure that there is no risk of the fault becoming a risk to safety. 7.5 TGO shall be entitled to require the Customer to change the signage relating to any of the Goods and in the event of this right being exercised by TGO the replacement signage shall be provided free of charge.

8. TITLE AND RISK

8.1 The risk in the Goods shall pass to the Customer on collection.

8.2 Title to the Goods shall not pass to the Customer until the earlier of;

(a) TGO receives payment in full for the Goods and

(b) The Customer resells the Goods in which case the title to the Goods shall pass to the Customers immediately before that resale has taken place.

9 PRICE AND PAYMENT

9.1 The price of the Goods shall be the price set out in the Order

9.2 The price of the Goods;

(a) Excludes amounts in respect of Value Added Tax (VAT) which the customer shall additionally be liable to pay to TGO at the prevailing rate, subject to the receipt of a valid VAT invoice and

(b) Excludes the costs and charges of packaging insurance and transport of the Goods.

9.3 The Customer shall pay the invoice in full within 30 days of the date of the invoice. Payment shall be made to the bank account nominated in writing by TGO

9.4 If the Customer fails to make any payment due to TGO under the Contract by the due date for payment then the Customer shall pay interest on the overdue amount at the rate of 10% per annum. Such interest shall accrue on a daily basis from the due date until actual payment of the overdue amount, whether before or after judgement. The Customer shall pay the interest together with the overdue amount.

9.5 The Customer shall pay all amounts due under the contract in full without any set-off, counterclaim, deduction or withholding (except for any deduction or withholding required by law). TGO may at any time without limiting any other rights or remedies it may have, set off any amount owing to it by the customer against any amount payable by TGO to the Customer.

9.6 In the event of the Customer cancelling the order made by the Customer and that cancellation is received by TGO before the Goods have been delivered by TGO to the Customer or collected by the Customer the Customer shall pay to TGO by way of liquidated and ascertained damages 50% of the price of the Goods within 14 days from the date of cancellation.

9.7 In the event of the Customer cancelling the order made by the Customer after the Goods have been delivered by TGO to the Customer or collected by the Customer the Customer shall pay to TGO 100% of the price within 28 days from delivery of the Goods to the Customer or collection of the Goods by the Customer.

10 INSTALLATION



10.1 This entire clause shall only apply to Contracts where TGO has agreed with the customer to install TGO Goods at a site nominated by the Customer. 10.2 In the event that this clause does apply and it then being found that there is a conflict between this clause and other clauses in these Terms and Conditions the provision made under this clause shall prevail.

10.3 The Customer shall obtain prior to commencement of the installation all necessary Consents statutory or otherwise required for the works of installation.

10.4 TGO will execute the works of installation using good and sound materials and in a proper and workmanlike manner.

10.5 The customer shall pay to TGO the price of the Goods and installation 30 days from the date of practical completion.

10.6 TGO shall certify the date of practical completion.

10.7 The risk in the Goods shall vest in the Customer as from the date of practical completion and the Public Liability risk in the installation as a whole shall vest in the Customer as from the date of practical completion.

10.8 The customer warrants that the ground conditions for the intended installation contain no special adverse properties or features. Should it be discovered that the Customer's site does have adverse properties or features TGO's surveyor shall define those adverse properties or features and the cost of overcoming the same so that the installation may proceed.

10.9 TGO will provide the customer with a copy of the report from the surveyor. The Customer will have 10 days in which to accept the report and pay for the additional works, or terminate the Contract by paying 25% of the contract Price in compensation.

10.10 In the event of the Customer electing to terminate the contract pursuant to clause 9.9 above the property in the Goods will remain with TGO and not with the Customer.

11 TERMINATION

11.1 Without limiting its other rights or remedies, TGO may terminate the Contract with immediate effect by giving a written notice to the Customer if: (a) The Customer commits a material breach of any term of the Contract and (if such a breach is remediable) fails to remedy that breach within 10 Business Days of that party being notified to do so;

(b) The Customer takes any step or action in connection with its entering administration, provisional liquidation or any composition or arrangement with its creditors (other than in relation to a solvent restructuring), being wound up (whether voluntarily or by Order of the Court, unless for the purpose of a solvent restructuring), having a receiver appointed to any of its assets or ceasing to carry on business.

(c) The Customer suspends, threatens to suspend, ceases or threatens to cease to carry on all or a substantial part of its business or

(d) The Customer's financial position deteriorates to such an extent that in TGO's opinion the Customer's capability to adequately fulfil its obligations under the Contract have been placed in jeopardy.

11.2 Without limiting its other rights or remedies, TGO may suspend provision of the Goods under any Contract it may have with the Customer if the Customer becomes subject to any of the events listed in clause 11.1(a) to Clause 11.1(d) or TGO reasonably believes that the Customer is about to become subject to any of them or if the Customer fails to pay any amount due under the contract on the due date for payment.

11.3 On termination of the contract for any reason the Customer shall immediately pay to TGO all of TGO's outstanding unpaid invoices and interest.

12 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

12.1 nothing in these conditions shall limit or exclude TGO's liability for:

(a) Death or personal injury caused by its negligence or the negligence of its employees, agents or sub-contractors

(b) Fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation

(c) Breach of the terms implied by Section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 or

(d) Defective products under the Consumer Protection Act 1987 or

(e) Any matter in respect of which it would be unlawful for TGO to exclude or restrict liability.

12.2 Subject to Clause 11.1:

(a) TGO shall under no circumstances whatsoever be liable to the Customer, whether in Contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty, or otherwise, for any loss of profit on any indirect or consequential loss arising under or in connection with the Contract and

(b) TGO's total liability to the Customer in respect of all other losses arising under or in connection with the Contract whether in Contract, tort (including negligence), breach of duty, or otherwise, shall in no circumstances exceed 150% of the price of the Goods.

13 FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be in breach of contract nor liable for delay in performing, or failing to perform, any of its obligations under the Contract if such delay of failure result from a Force Majeure Event. If the period of delay or non-performance continues for 13 weeks then either party may terminate the Contract by giving 2 weeks written notice to the other.

14 GENERAL

14.1 Assignment and other dealings.

(a) TGO may at any time assign, transfer, mortgage, charge, sub-contract or deal in any manner with all or any of its rights or obligations under the contract. (b) The Customer may not assign, transfer, mortgage, charge, sub-contract, declare a trust over or deal in any other manner with any or all of its rights or obligations under the contract without the prior written consent of TGO.

14.2 Entire Agreement.

(a) The Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes and extinguishes all previous agreements, promises, assurances, warranties, representations and understandings between them, whether written or oral, relating to its subject matter.

(b) Each party agrees that it shall have no remedies in respect of any statement, representation, assurance or warranty (whether made innocently or negligently) that is not set out in this agreement.

No variation of the Contract shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by a director of TGO or an authorised representative of the Customer 14.4 Severance

If any provision or part-provision of the Contract is or becomes invalid, illegal or unenforceable, it shall be deemed modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it valid, legal and enforceable. If such modification is not possible, the relevant provision or part-provision shall be deemed deleted. Any modification to or deletion of a provision or part-provision under this clause shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the rest of the Contract. 14.5 Notices

(a) Any notice or other communication given to a party under or in connection with the Contract shall be in writing addressed to its principle place of business or such other address as that party may have specified to the other in writing in accordance with this clause and shall be delivered personally, sent by pre-paid 1st Class post or other next working day delivery service, commercial courier, or email.

(b) The provisions of this clause shall not apply to the service of any proceedings or other documents in any legal action.

14.6 Third Party Rights

No one other than a party to this Contract and their permitted assignees shall have any right to enforce any of its terms. 14.7 Governing Law

The contract and any dispute or claim arising out it or in connection with it or its subject or formation shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales.


14.8 Jurisdiction

Dear Rebecca and Panetta.

Following on from the telephone conversation I had with you concerning the Duck weed and fallen tree in the quarry pond I can now give you a quote regarding this.

The water level is quite high at present and removing the tree at this time would be difficult and risky. It has been there for quite sometime and does not pose a hazard although unsightly. As the summer progresses and the water level drops we could cut this up and remove it without any problems. The Cost to do this work would be £180.

The Duck weed which can reproduce every 16hrs poses a more awkward situation. In the past we have put a boom across the pond and dragged the weed carefully down to one end of the pond and then removed the weed manually. This can be done from either side of the bank. At this time of the year with long daylight hours the weed does grow quickly and to keep the pond looking reasonably clear this process needs to be repeated every 3 or 4 weeks into September. Then as the water in the pond starts to cool down and the daylight decreases the weed slows down.

The Cost to remove this weed using this method would be £280 per visit.

I hope this is information is useful.
